

For Members and Visitors at The Undercroft Bridge Club

The Undercroft Bridge Club is committed to providing the best possible playing environment where its members always treat each other with respect and dignity.

The Code of Conduct (Code) describes standards of conduct that promote adherence to the values of the Undercroft Bridge Club.

All members, guests and visitors are expected to exercise sound judgement and live up to both the content and spirit of the Code.

The Undercroft Bridge Club (UBC) Code of Conduct (this document) establishes the standards of behaviour expected of Members and their Guests.

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of Members and their guests
- 2. Be fair, considerate, polite and courteous in dealing with others
- 3. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility including in areas of punctuality, personal hygiene and the use of mobile phones.
- 4. Do not use coarse, obscene or sexually suggestive, racist, misogynist or discriminatory language or behaviour.
- 5. Refrain from any form of abuse towards others. This includes verbal, online and digital abuse.
- 6. Refrain from any form of harassment towards, or discrimination of others.
- 7. Promote and maintain UBC, BAWA & ABF standards, rules, regulations and policies
- 8. Operate within the Laws of Bridge.
- 9. Treat the Director with respect at all times.
 - Act in the interests of all concerned and politely call the Director to your table if you think there has been an irregularity.
 - Any ruling made by the Director shall be accepted at the time of the ruling.
 - If clarification/interpretation etc is needed this should be the subject of discussion during the break or after play.
- 10. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick, injured, or with a disability.
- 11. Do not misuse the personal information of Members, including email address and phone numbers. This includes providing and/or making Members personal information available to third parties without authorisation.

Issues related to a breach of this Code of Conduct should be brought to the attention of the Club President, preferably in writing. Consequences of a breach to the Code of Conduct will be determined by the Recorders who will make a recommendation to the Management Committee. The Management Committee will then determine any appropriate disciplinary action which may include suspension and/or expulsion.
